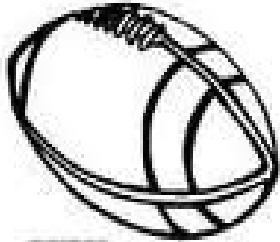
## OPENING NIGHT SOCIAL EVENT

### **Club Bar Licence**

The Club continues to welcome all friends, family and visitors to the Club throughout the season. There is nothing more pleasing than seeing the Clubrooms full each week, and at the end of the day the bar turnover supports the operation of the Club.

However all members need to be aware that the conditions of our Bar Licence requires that all non-financial members of the Club sign the Visitors Book at the bar.

Should we get an inspection throughout the season, and we are seen to be serving any person who is un-financial, or alternatively has not signed the Visitors Book, could lead to a fine and closure of the Bar for a period.

We therefore appeal to all members to –

- (a) Carry their Membership Card on them at all times (issued on payment of annual subscription)
- (b) When bringing visitors to the Club, please ensure they sign the Visitor's Book in the Foyer each time they come along. The alternative is to get them to sign up as a social member for a cost of \$20.

Please don't be offended if Bar Staff ask for your membership card during the season.

The Bar is licenced to 11pm each night, and later on Club event nights, so please don't be offended if Bar staff ask you to leave at our official closing time. It is important we stick to the requirements of our licence.
